MISSIONARY HIGHLIGHT

THE LUKE COMMISSION/VANDERWALS - ESWATINI

Campus Construction: We are grateful to God for the completion of our campus hospital (SCSC) and inpatient facility (TOB). We do not yet know what COVID-19 will bring, but we are so grateful that we have these two facilities as tools for caring for both potential and confirmed COVID-19 cases.



COVID-19 Screening: Early on, TLC established a dedicated outdoor COVID-19 screening station. TLC has screened nearly 3,000 people for COVID-19 in the month of May, and sends COVID-19 tests to a lab for those who screen most at-risk. We have nearly 300 cases in Eswatini but not a lot of testing. We have been keeping some COVID + patients at the campus. TLC is working very closely with the government to support them for suspected and confirmed cases.

Staff Attitudes: Staff attitudes are amazing, even in the uncertainty of COVID-19. The team is engaged and focused. I would invite your prayers for the team to continue to follow the Holy Spirit's leading toward peace and unity.

Forgiveness/reconciliation: We currently have a group of prospective team members going through our initial training program, which we call Base Camp. As part of Base Camp, participants have an opportunity to meet with one of our staff counselors and process unhealed hurts and trauma. Oftentimes, participants find new freedom as they choose to forgive those who have hurt them. Pray for an ongoing openness for participants to face unhealed pain and invite God's healing through forgiveness.
